Communication, Language and Phonics

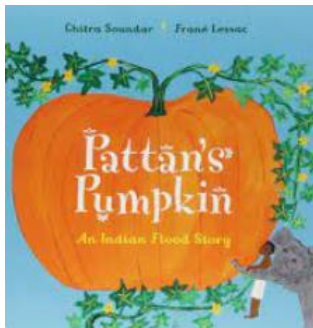
We will be revising the phonemes b, g, u, n.
