This week In Year 2 we are learning:

English 	To select vocabulary to describe. To identify books on a theme. To write a paragraph about a wolf. To describe using adjectives.
Phonics 	To know the graphemes: ear (learn), wr (wrong), st (listen). To read the tricky words: many, friend, any, through, two, your, laugh, because, eye.
Maths 	To know how to count in 10s on a number line. To understand number lines with intervals of 1. To estimate numbers on a number line.
Handwriting 	To write one armed robot letters (r, b, n, h, m, k, p) and long ladder letters (l, i, t, u, j, y).
– Games 	To throw and catch a ball accurately.
PE – Gymnastics 	To learn point and patch balances and perform some on the floor.
Science 	To know the properties of different materials.
RE 	To know what an expert and guide is. To know that Christians believe God is an expert and guide.
PSHE 	To listen to other people and contribute my own ideas about rewards and consequences. To help make my class a safe and fair place.
Mindfulness 	To use breathing techniques to aid mindfulness.
Computing 	To recognise whether a website is appropriate for children and what to do if you are unsure of something online eg: tell an adult.
History 	To understand the history of traditional tales and where they come from.
Reading 	To explain what has happened so far in what they have read. To answer questions and make some inferences. To make a plausible prediction on what might happen based on what has been read so far.
