
















Week beginning 2nd October 2023

English 	To write an introduction to a non-chronological report To write a non-chronological report
Phonics 	To know the graphemes: eigh (eight), aigh (straight), ey (grey), ea (great), kn (know), gn (sign), mb (thumb), eer (cheer) To read the tricky words: busy, beautiful, pretty, hour
Maths 	To know number bonds to 10 To recall number bonds to 10 and use these to calculate number bonds to 20 To use knowledge of number bonds within 10 to understand related facts to 100 To use knowledge of number bonds to 10 to calculate number bonds to 100
Handwriting 	To write capital letters using correct formation (A, B, D, G, H, Q, R, Y)
Reading 	To use 'Prediction Pip' to say what a story might be about (from front cover) and what might happen next 
PE – Games 	To throw and catch a ball in different ways To create a game where you throw and catch a ball in different ways
PE – Gymnastics 	To continue to develop and apply different balances using low apparatus
Science 	To investigate how the shapes of solid objects can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching
RE 	To know how God might be like a shepherd to his people To know what difference it might make for Christians to experience God as their shepherd
PSHE 	To understand how following a Learning Charter will help me and others learn To work cooperatively
Mindfulness 	To use breathing techniques to aid mindfulness
Computing 	To discuss the rules around how to stay safe online <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep personal information private • Don't talk to people you don't know • Ask an adult before going online

Music 	To find simple melodic patterns using high and low notes
