# **Declaration and Early Years Pupil Premium Form**

In order for your child to receive Funded Early Education, parents of **all children** in the Nursery are required to complete <u>Surrey County Council's Declaration and Early Years Pupil Premium</u>

<u>Form</u> once their child has attended their first session. If you are unable to print this, please ask for a paper copy from the school office. Please note that 'Universal funded' relates to 15 hours which

all parents are entitled to and 'Extended funded' relates to those who are eligible for 30 hours funding. Holmesdale School offers are term-time only.

This form will apply for the whole academic year so please complete the autumn, spring and summer funding periods now and **please contact the school office immediately** if any changes occur after completion or you become eligible for Early Years Pupil Premium.

Please return your completed form to the school office no later than Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September.

# **30 Hours Funding**

If your child receives funding for 30 hours, please remember to reconfirm your eligibility every three months to continue claiming the extra hours. You should receive a prompt from the HMRC to remind you to do this. However, it is advisable to make a note of your renewal date yourself to make sure you don't miss the deadline and lose out on your funding.
