Childhood Flu Programme

All children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 will be offered flu vaccinations on **Thursday 19**th **October**. Please register your consent online. In the <u>Surrey Immunisation Team's letter</u> you will find the link to the Immunisation Flu Portal and the school's Unique Reference Number (URN). Copy and paste the URN and click on the link – this will take you to the correct page where you can fill out the online consent. The deadline to register is **12 noon on Monday 16**th **October**, but please do register as soon as possible to enable enough time for administration. Even if you do not want your child to have the vaccination you will still need to register your preference.

Parent Consultation Evenings

You are invited to make a 10-minute appointment with your child's teacher on either **Wednesday** 18th (4.30-7.30pm) or Thursday 19th October (3.30-6.30pm) to discuss how your child has settled into their new class. The appointments will be held in school in your child's classroom. Details of how to book your appointment will be emailed to you with the Notices this week. Bookings will close at 3pm on Tuesday 17th October.
