#### Word and Sound Books

We use the phonics programme, Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised to teach phonics. Please <u>click here</u> for more information about Little Wandle and an overview of phonics for the year.

This week your our child will bring home a 'Word and Sound Book' with the graphemes that we have learnt thus far. Please encourage your child to recognise the grapheme and say the phoneme catch phrase. Little Wandle have recorded clips on how to say each phoneme to support parents.

#### NumBots

Please do encourage your child to continue to use NumBots at home to help support their number fact fluency. Your child's log in details remain the same as in Reception and Year 1. NumBots is an online game and playing little and often will significantly improve your child's recall and understanding of number bonds and addition and subtraction facts. These are critical foundations in maths so we are excited by the impact NumBots will have.

#### Little and often

In order to get the best out of NumBots children should regularly play for short bursts so we would ask you to give them at least 3 minutes, four or five times a week.

#### Game Types

- 1. Story Mode the emphasis is on learning the ideas and concepts behind addition and subtraction so it features more diagrams, shapes and question styles.
- 2. Challenge Mode the emphasis is more on speed of recall of key facts, like number bonds to 10, doubling small numbers or adding & taking away in your head
