This week In Year 2 we are learning:

English 	To plan a half term recount. To write a recount about a real event. To use apostrophes for contractions (do not = don't, can not = can't).
Maths 	To make equal groups by sharing. To understand division as sharing equally. To use the division symbol for equal groups.
Whole class reading 	To use the 'Pawsome Gang' to answer written comprehension questions. To infer how a character might be feeling or why something has happened.
Little Wandle Spelling 	Why do some words have the spellings kn and gn for /n/, and wr for /r/? <u>What are silent letters? - BBC Bitesize</u>
PSHE 	To show or tell you what relaxed means and to know some things that make me feel relaxed and some that make me feel stressed. To tell you when a feeling is weak and when a feeling is strong.
PE – Dance 	To learn a line dance.
PE – Gym 	To learn different rolls and spins. Skill: Rotation.
Mindfulness 	To use breathing techniques to aid mindfulness.
Art 	To do an observational drawing of a bike.
Handwriting 	To practise horizontal join to ascender, joining wh, oh. Words – whizzing, wheel, white, whale. To introduce horizontal and diagonal joins, to ascender, to an anticlockwise letter. Join – of, if. Words – soft, lift, loft.
Geography 	To know the physical features of our planet i.e. grass, mountains, rivers, lakes, ocean, volcanoes.

Science 	<u>Knowledge Harvest - Everyday Materials</u> To know the uses of everyday materials. To write questions about what I would like to know.
History 	<u>Knowledge Harvest – Transport</u> To recall what I already know about transport. To write questions about what I would like to know.
Music 	To begin to recognise the basic style indicators of Reggae music.
