Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children are becoming very good at listening to one another during our weekly Jigsaw sessions. This week we will be talking about how we feel proud when we have achieved something.

Communication and Language

The children will be learning the names of the 2D shapes - triangle, square, oblong, circle, oval and star. We will be describing these shapes by counting the number of sides and corners they have. The children will then go on to guess the shape by listening to the descriptions.

Literacy

The children are really enjoying our Little Wandle phonics sessions and are continuing to introduce a different letter sound each week, this week's sound was 'g'. It might be fun to play 'I Spy with my Little Eye' at home.

Mathematics

We will be going on a shape walk to see what 2D shapes we can see in our environment. We will be taking photos of the children with the shapes they find and making a class shape photo book. Please do point out circles, squares, triangles, oblongs and hexagons that you see at home.

Physical Development

We have been so impressed by the children's perseverance in recent weeks with their cutting skills! We will continue to practice our cutting when we make pictures using different 2D shapes.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be setting up a vet practice in our role play area and encouraging the children to mark make; writing prescriptions, taking telephone messages, writing appointments etc.

The children will also be learning some shapes songs.
