Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Communication and Language

Mathematics

We will be focusing on sequencing events in a day starting with dawn.


We will use the language of 'first' and 'next' whilst sequencing the story of *Rosie's Walk*.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about the life cycle of a hen and watching videos of chicks hatching. We will be finding out fun facts about the incubation period of an egg and what the mother hen does to look after her eggs and chicks.

Physical Development
