## **Pupil Premium**

If you have a child in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and you are eligible to register for Pupil Premium, please complete <u>FSM Application Form</u> and return it to the school office by **Friday 26**<sup>th</sup> **April.** 

More information is given in the <u>Handbook for Parents September 2023</u> (available on our website). <u>Eligibility criteria 1 – if either parent is in receipt of the following:</u>

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income support
- Income based Jobseeker's Allowance (IBJSA)
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA)
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual gross income of no more than £16,190, as assessed by HMRC. N.B. If you receive WORKING TAX CREDIT you do NOT qualify even if you receive child tax credit and your income is below £16,190

• Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

Eligibility criteria 2 – Application for other pupil premium

- If your child is a looked-after child (LAC) i.e. in the care of, or provided with accommodation by an English local authority
- If your child ceased to be looked after by the local authority because of adoption, a special guardianship order, a child arrangements order or a residence order.
- If either or both parents are regular members of HM Forces and designated as personal category 1 or 2 (PStat Cat 1 or 2), in the armed forces of another nation and stationed in England or in receipt of a child pension from the Ministry of Defence.

Eligibility criteria 3 – no recourse to public funds

If you are a family with no recourse to public funds and your immigration category is one of the following, please complete the <u>Application form for No Recourse to Public Funds</u> Zambrano Article 8 of the ECHR Section 4 of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999 Chen BN(O) Passport holder Spousal visa holder Work visa holder Student visa holder Other

If your circumstances change during the course of the year and you become eligible for the above, please complete the form and send it to the school office at that time.

#### **Collection of Seeds**

#### **30 Hours Funding**
