Toy diary

Over the summer term each child will be asked to create a short diary of their favourite toy's 'adventures'. Your children can make as many or as few entries into the diary as they wish e.g., did the toy go to the park, shops, football etc? What did they have for breakfast? For each entry

your child can stick photos, draw pictures, write captions, labels or sentences, or you can act as their scribe.

You may even like to add in any postcards or tickets of places the toy visits with you.

The purpose of this diary is to encourage your child to use their speaking, listening, creative and writing skills. You can present the diary in any form you like e.g., in a book form, as a long strip of paper (timeline) or on a poster. Please encourage your child to talk with you about the events in their diary so they are confident to talk about it at school.

You will be given advanced notice of when it is your child's turn and when their diary should be started and brought to school. Your child will then share their toy's adventure with their peers in class.
