The children will be using their fine motor skills to make beanstalks out of strips of green card. They will punch holes and use treasury tags to connect the strips together.

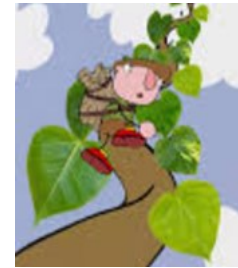
Mathematics
