Personal, Social and Emotional Development

During circle time we will be talking about why it is important to wash our hands and know it is important to do this before I eat and after I go to the toilet.

Mathematics

We will be focusing on counting the different features on the minibeasts, and asking questions such as how many legs does it have, how many wings, etc.
