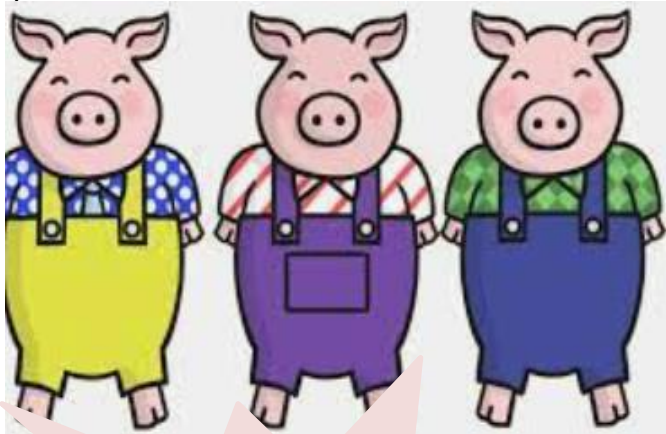


Personal Social Emotional Development

Maths



In maths we will be comparing quantities and looking carefully at the language of comparison to describe sets of objects we can see e.g. more than, fewer than.

Communication, Language and Phonics

In phonics we will be learning the phonemes; v, w, x, y and the tricky words; and, has, his, her.

We will also be revisiting all the phonemes and tricky words we have learnt so far.

We will continue to develop our decoding and blending skills to read a short phrase. E.g. a red hat.



Physical Development

In the woodlands we will be learning to navigate the space safely. We will also be using our fine motor skills to create leaf and bark rubbings. In Funky Fingers we will be continuing to strengthen our arm, shoulder and finger muscles to support the writing process.
