







<p>Reading</p> 	<p>To read 'Handa's Surprise' by Eileen Browne and discuss the vocabulary.</p> <p>To identify adjectives.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>To use our sense of smell.</p> <p>To use simple equipment and make observations when carrying out an investigation.</p>

<p>PSHE</p> 	<p>To know some people who I could talk to if I was feeling unhappy or being bullied. To be kind to children who are feeling unhappy.</p>
<p>Music</p> 	<p>We will be learning Christmas songs and poems.</p> <p><u>Song of the week:</u> Wild Man by Kate Bush</p> <p>To listen to and talk about what they like or dislike about the piece of music. To name instruments they can hear or see. To decide if the music fast or slow. To explain how the music makes them feel.</p>
<p>DT</p> 	<p>To use practice using our fine motor skills to cut and stick.</p>
<p>PE</p> 	<p>To explore actions in response to the story of 'Handa's Surprise'. To perform a sequence of movements inspired by the story 'Handa's Surprise'. To travel on feet on floor (with jumps and leaps) with accuracy and control.</p>
<p>Geography</p> 	<p>To learn that we live in England in the continent of Europe. To learn that Kenya is in the continent of Africa. To know that the weather is different in Kenya compared to the weather in the UK.</p>
