Jam Jar Tombola - From 29th April

Raffle - Tickets / Hampers

As part of the raffle we will be offering the chance to win 1 of 11 colour hampers. Each class will be asked to pull together a colour hamper, which will include many treats (more details will be received from your class rep). These hampers are a great success and people love to win one. Please support the raffle by selling the tickets that will come home in your child's book bag before half term and by bringing the stubs and cash in a sealed envelope to the PSA shop (or into the PSA postbox) before the fair, or by purchasing at the fair. Please ask at the PSA shop if you require further tickets.


