In our Jigsaw lesson this week, we will learn to recognise and talk about ways in which we can manage our feelings.



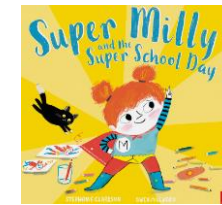
Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)
