## **Mark Making**

### **Literacy**

The children have been enjoying our nursery rhymes and we will continue to sing these and use the nursery rhyme props alongside our singing.

This week we will be singing 'Twinkle Twinkle Little Star' and playing some alliteration and rhyming games.

### **Physical Development (PD)**

The children will be encouraged to develop their fine motor skills by mark making in different ways this week, using felt tips, crayons, chalk and printing with paint.

### **Maths**

Every week will be practicing counting out loud. We will count claps, jumps, taps, pats. We will also continue to sing our number rhymes.

### **Understanding the World (UW)**

We are making the 'All about me sheets' into a class book. We will be spending time looking at these with the children and talking to them about their family and friends so that they can name and describe the people who are familiar to them.
