














Weeks beginning 6th October 2025

This week In Year 2 we are learning:

<p>English</p> 	<p>Jim and the Beanstalk</p> <p>To make plausible predictions about events in a story. To learn how to represent speech in writing using speech bubbles. To use conjunctions such as because, and, but, so and or to extend sentences. To identify the key events in the story and sequence them.</p> 
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>To compare numbers using greater than, less than and equal to. To order objects and numbers using comparison vocabulary. To count in 2s, 5s and 10s.</p>
<p>Phonics</p> 	<p>To revisit and review phase 5 phonemes: 'oo'/'yoo' – oo, u, u_e, ew, ue, ou, ui 'air' – air, are, ear, ere 'ur' – er, ur, ir, or, ear 'ow' – ou, ow</p> <p>To revisit and review the tricky words: through, improve, move, prove, use, useful, new, drew, their, parents</p>
<p>Handwriting</p> 	<p>To write capital letters using correct formation</p>
<p>PE – Golf</p> 	<p>To perform a variety of actions with the ball keeping it under control. To know how to defend between ball and target. To begin to understand the importance of preparing safely and carefully for exercise.</p>
<p>PSHE</p> 	<p><u>Feeling Good Friday</u></p> <p>To be able to recognise and name different emotions that everyone experiences. To explain how taking notice can help us to be mindful of our thoughts and feelings.</p>
<p>Mindfulness</p> 	<p>To use breathing techniques to aid mindfulness.</p>
<p>Reading</p> 	<p><u>Little Wandle group reading</u></p> <p>We will be reading and enjoying books in small groups this week focusing on word reading, prosody and comprehension.</p>
