Autumn

Communication and Language (CL)

As part of learning about autumn, we will be using vocabulary such as acorns, conkers, leaves, trees, orange, yellow, green, brown, crisp, changing, colourful, windy, crunch, rustling, falling, twirling. Please encourage your child to talk about what they can see when out on walks and model this language with them. Please see the word mat attached.

Physical Development (PD)

We will be continuing to develop our fine and gross motor skills by accessing the indoor and outdoor learning environments.

Literacy

We will be looking at non-fiction books to learn all about autumn.

We will also be learning a new number song called '5 Autumn Leaves' and learning other autumn poems.

Maths

We will introduce our Number of the Week, number 1. We will notice what we have 1 of, for example 1 nose, 1 mouth etc. We will also look at the numeral 1 and have a look to see if we can find it around our environment. At home, please continue to point out the number 1 and what you can find 1 of, for example 1 toothbrush, 1 spoon etc.

Understanding the World (UW)

We will be talking about seasons and learning about autumn. When you are walking with your child outside, talk about the changes that you can see in the colour of the leaves, things that fall from the trees and the change in temperature. It would be lovely if they can bring in some autumn objects that they find, for example conkers, acorns and leaves for our autumn display.
