Maths

We will have a number of the week this week and learn about the number 5.

We will be practicing our counting and knowing that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total.

We will also be going to the Woodland on Monday and Friday to do a number hunt.

Communication and Language (CL)

The children are really enjoying our Traditional Tales topic and enjoyed retelling the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears last week. This week we will be encouraging the children to say the repeated language from 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff.' For example, 'Who's that crossing over MY bridge?' or 'trip, trap, trip trap over the bridge.' There is a vocabulary word mat attached.

Physical Development (PD)

We will be doing lots of activities to develop our gross motor skills. As it is Feeling Good Week, we will be doing lots of dancing and playing movement games both indoors and outdoors. We will also be learning some pilates moves to help us with our balance and core stability.
