Physical Development

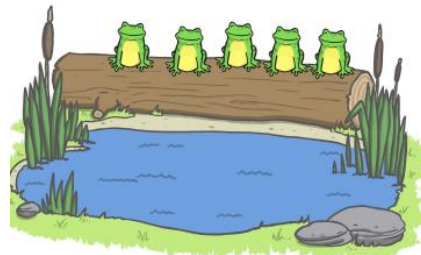
