This week we will be focusing on repeating patterns. We will be noticing and correcting an error in a repeating pattern. When you are at home and out and about, please look out for and discuss with your child any repeating patterns that you might see, for example zebra crossings, railway lines, bricks.

Understanding of the World (UW)

We will be learning about Pancake Day and how people celebrate it. We will be talking about our own traditions and what our favourite pancake toppings are.

We will be making our own pancakes. We will observe how the ingredients change during the process and use our senses to smell and taste our own delicious pancakes!

Physical Development (PD)

We will be developing our gross motor skills by having 'pancake races' using a beanbag and a racquet.
