We will be reading *Kipper's Toy Box* and will practice retelling the story. If you would like to watch the story being read at home, please follow this link:

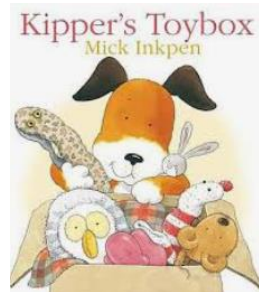
