Physical Development

Communication, Language and Phonics

In phonics this week we will reading words that end in s but make the /z/ sound (chairs) and words that end in es but make the /iz/ (boxes) sound. We will be reviewing all tricky words from the autumn and spring term.

Maths



This week in maths, we will be learning about length, mass, and capacity. We will measure length using cubes and compare objects using words like shorter, longer, and taller. We will explore mass by using scales and describing objects as heavier, lighter, or balanced. We will also investigate capacity by looking at how much different containers can hold.

Understanding the World
