## Maths



This week in maths, we will be building on our understanding of numbers by exploring their order up to 8, focusing on where each number sits in the counting sequence. We will learn to compare numbers using key language such as 'more than,' 'less than,' 'fewer than' and 'equal to.' We will use this vocabulary to describe number relationships and to support understanding of number position.

## Physical Development



We will be enjoying strengthening our gross motor skills in the outside classroom. We will create an obstacle course where we must ride the bikes around the different cones and practise ball skills through a variety of activities.

## Understanding the World



This week we will be talking about change and growth. We will talk about what seeds need to grow and think about where we should keep the seeds we have planted. Over the next few weeks, we will use our observational skills to watch closely for changes to our seeds.
