







| <p><b>PSHE</b></p>         | <p>To identify what being a good friend means to me.<br/>To know how to make a new friend.</p>  |
| <p><b>Music</b></p>        | <p>To listen to and talk about what they like or dislike about the piece of music.<br/>To name instruments they can hear or see.<br/>To decide if the music is fast or slow.<br/>To explain how the music makes them feel.</p>                                    |
| <p><b>PE</b></p>           | <p>To develop coordination in a range of activities.<br/>To explore and practise a variety of movements.<br/>To work independently and with others.<br/>To practise working to solve problems.<br/>To cooperate with other children in small groups.</p>          |
| <p><b>Computing</b></p>   | <p>To understand that when a computer does something it is following a set of instructions called 'code'.<br/>To give instructions to make objects on the screen move when the program starts.<br/>To use code to make objects move when they are clicked on.</p> |
| <p><b>Geography</b></p>  | <p>To investigate how we feel about our playground.<br/>To create a design to improve our own playground.</p>   |
