Maths



In maths this week we will be exploring numbers to 10 by learning about doubles, when two equal parts join to make a whole. We will compare groups to see if they are equal or not equal, using familiar resources such as dice, fingers and pictures. We will practise subitising (recognising amounts quickly) and begin to recall simple doubles facts, such as $3 + 3 = 6$, without always needing resources
