

Literacy

The children will listen to stories such as *Oi, Get Off our Train!* and *The Train Ride* and retell the story using story maps. We will also read some non-fiction books to learn about trains and travel.

Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

We will be creating a train station in the role play area and we will build a train for the children to 'ride.'

We will be cutting 2D shapes to make our own train pictures.

We will also learn some train songs and rhymes.

Communication and Language (CL)

We will be encouraging the children to talk about any journeys they have made. We will compare journeys they have made on trains, buses, cars, or planes, and talk about whether they have ever been on a train ride to visit someone.

We will also learn some train songs and rhymes, please see attached 'Down at the station' and 'I'm a Little Engine' if you would like to sing them at home.

Understanding of the World (UW)

We will be going for a walk to the train station and talk about the landmarks that we spot on our journey, for example the post box, church and zebra crossing. We will then challenge ourselves to talk about what we saw on our journey and draw a map of our route, including some of the landmarks that we saw.
