Maths



In maths this week we will be revisiting 'composition'. We will be using songs and rhymes to discuss the composition of numbers to 5. E.g. 4 and 1 make 5. We will also be revisiting ways to make 6 and 7 using the '5 and a bit' model. E.g. I can make 7 with 5 and 2 and I can use my fingers to show this (5 fingers on one hand and 2 on the other).
