RECEPTION LEARNING

Communication, Language and Phonics

In phonics this week we will be reading CCVC, CCCVC, CCV and CCVCC words. Such as; sweet, sprain, tree and scoop. (C-consonant, V-vowel)

The words we are now reading contain more phonemes, so we will make sure that we say every sound we see and blend them together carefully.

Physical Development

Maths

We will then begin learning about the number **10**, looking at different ways it can be made using two smaller numbers. Can you practise learning number bonds to 10 at home by using your fingers. 'I have 10 fingers, if 3 fingers are down, how many are still up?' 10 is made of 3 and 7.
