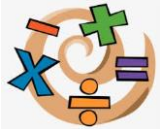
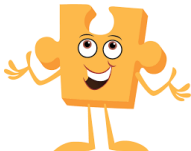


Year 1

This week we are learning:	
English 	To plan a letter. To write sequenced sentences.
Phonics 	We will be reviewing all the sounds we have learnt so far. We will be reviewing all the tricky words we have learnt so far.
Handwriting 	To form diagonal joins from letters to ascenders correctly.
Maths 	To use pre-money counters to understand that value is not linked to physical appearance and that a single item can represent more than one in value. To recognise and understand the value of coins. To recognise and understand the value of notes.
Reading 	To read for pleasure.
Science 	To identify and name wild and garden plants. To sort flowers into groups. To learn about recycling and why it is important.
PSHE 	To tell you some things about me that have changed and some things about me that have stayed the same. To know that changes are OK and that sometimes they will happen whether I want them to or not.
Music 	To listen to and talk about what they like or dislike about the piece of music. To name instruments they can hear or see. To decide if the music fast or slow. To explain how the music makes them feel.

PE 	To explore different ways to use/move with the ball. To watch and copy movements. To know a compass and directions (N,E,S,W). To begin to plan how to solve problems.
Geography 	To draw a sketch map.
RE 	To think about what makes the world precious.
