

Literacy

We will look at a variety of information books and stories with an African theme such as *We're all going on Safari*.

If you have any books at home about African animals that your child would like to share on the carpet, please feel free to bring these in. Please name the books before they come in.

Understanding of the World (UW)

We will be learning about Africa and using a globe and an atlas to look at the different terrain within the continent. We will be learning about the Maasai tribe and compare where some of them live to where we live.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

This week we will be naming parts of our body and talking about showing respect for ourselves.

Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

We will be listening to a variety of African music and copying simple rhythms using body parts. We will also be going to the music room to play on the African drums.

We will also be designing our own African clay 'pinch' pots.

Communication and Language (CL)

The children will be encouraged to talk about aspects of the African culture and share their observations through role-play and exploring African artefacts.

The children will be encouraged to talk about what they find interesting and what they have found out. They will also learn the vocabulary savannah, mountains, desert, jungle, safari, waterfall, continent, country, globe.
