













Week beginning 11th September 2023

English 	To write sentences using capital letters and full stops. To plan and write a fact file 'All About Me'. To edit sentences.
Phonics 	To know the graphemes: tch (catch), ture (picture), al (calm), a (mask). To read the tricky words: because, eye.
Maths 	To partition numbers to 100 into tens and ones. To partition numbers to 100 in different ways. To write numbers up to 100 in words. To write numbers to 100 in expanded form.
Handwriting 	To write curly caterpillar letters using correct formation (a, c, o, d, g, q, e, s, f).
PE – Games 	To be able to throw and catch a beanbag with two hands or one hand. To balance a beanbag on different body parts.
PE – Gymnastics 	To learn point and patch balances.
