Physical Development

This week we will be practising writing our letters and number using the correct formation. We will also be practising our cutting skills.

In our woodland session this week we will be enjoying a campfire! We will learn how to be safe around a fire and have a go at toasting some bread.

Communication, Language and Phonics

This week we will be reading phase 4 words ending in -er and -est. We will practise chunking up longer words. For example, jump/er, strong/est. We will also be reviewing phonemes; tricky words and words we have read this year.

Maths



This week we will be reviewing our learning and exploring numbers to ten. We will be combining and splitting quantities in different ways. We will focus on investigating doubles, odd and even numbers, and learn how numbers can be made from two parts. We will develop our understanding of number patterns, recognise mathematical relationships, and build confidence in explaining their thinking through practical activities and visual resources.

Understanding the World

This week we will be learning all about maps. We will be looking at maps of the world and maps of the school. We will compare them and look at how they are different. When looking at the map of the school we will be using it to find key points in the playground.
