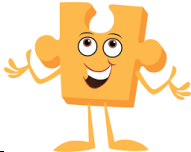


Year 1

This week we are learning:	
English 	To use conjunctions such as and, but, because. To use exciting language in writing.
Phonics 	We will be learning these new sounds: Monday: /zh/ su si Tuesday: /zh/ su si Wednesday: /j/ dge We will be learning these new tricky words: Move Improve
Handwriting 	To keep writing on the lines and evenly sized. To form letters correctly.
Maths 	To read and tell the time to the half hour using an analogue clock.
Reading 	To read for pleasure.
Science 	To recognise the importance of a scientist's role. To use observations to find answers to questions.
PSHE 	To identify the parts of the body that make boys different to girls and use the correct names for these: penis, testicles, vulva, anus. To respect my body and understand which parts are private.
Music	To listen to and talk about what they like or dislike about the piece of music. To name instruments they can hear or see.

	To decide if the music is fast or slow. To explain how the music makes them feel. To sing these songs: - On your Way Home - James and the Giant Peach On Your Way Home ~ James and the Giant Peach: The Musical - Explorer and the Bear - Paddington The Explorer & The Bear - When I Grow Up - Matilda Matilda - When I Grow Up with lyrics
PE 	To learn different ways of controlling a ball. To work together as a team. To throw at a target.
RE 	To learn about the Jewish festival of TuB'Shevat and to discuss what trees provide us with.
DT 	To design a windup toy. To create a windup toy To evaluate the windup toy.

We have added alien words; these are words that will not make sense but can be decoded and blended. Don't forget to look out for those digraphs and trigraphs.
