Dinosaurs

Understanding of the World (UW)

We will be learning about what a palaeontologist does as a job. We will be discovering facts about dinosaurs, sharing our knowledge about them with our friends and identifying what else we would like to learn.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

This week we will be talking about how we feel moving on from Nursery. We will talk about how it is normal to feel both excited and worried and what we can do if we are feeling nervous.

We will be playing lots of dinosaur games to practice the skill of linking numerals to amounts.

Communication and Language (CL)

We will be encouraging the children to use and learn a range of descriptive language. We will be using words such as huge, enormous, gigantic, slimy, fierce, claws, spikey, scales, sharp etc.
