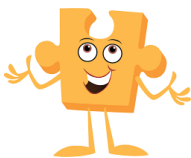


Year 1

This week we are learning:	
English 	To extend my sentences using conjunctions. To choose and use appropriate adjectives.
Phonics 	We will be learning these new sounds: /j/ dge /i/ y /j/ ge We will be learning these new tricky words: Parents Shoe
Handwriting 	To begin to form a diagonal join from letters to ascenders correctly.
Maths 	To split numbers into tens and ones. To write fact families. To find one more and one less. To practice number formation. To use different coins and notes to make a number.
Reading 	To read for pleasure.
Science 	To observe changes across the seasons. To spot patterns in data. To describe and compare the features of animals. To carry out research to find specific information.
PSHE 	To understand that every time I learn something new, I change a little bit. To enjoy learning new things. To tell you about changes that have happened in my life. To know some ways to cope with changes.

Music 	To listen to and talk about what they like or dislike about the piece of music. To name instruments they can hear or see. To decide if the music is fast or slow. To explain how the music makes them feel. Learn the following songs: - On your Way Home - James and the Giant Peach <u>On Your Way Home ~ James and the Giant Peach: The Musical</u> - Explorer and the Bear - Paddington <u>The Explorer & The Bear</u> - When I Grow Up - Matilda <u>Matilda - When I Grow Up with lyrics</u>
PE 	To show control and accuracy when rolling the ball. To use skills in different ways in different games. To describe why running and playing games is good for them. To learn different ways of controlling a ball. To work together as a team. To throw at a target.
Geography 	To identify physical and human features of a non-European country. To describe what it is like in Shanghai.
DT and Art 	To design a bag using fabric pens. To create a wooden ornament.

Below are some words you may like to practise reading with your child at home. Remember - the red words are tricky as we can't decode and blend them! We have added alien words, these are words that will not make sense but can be decoded and blended. Don't forget to look out for those digraphs and trigraphs. If your child would like a challenge, can they choose a few of the words to practise writing and spelling?
