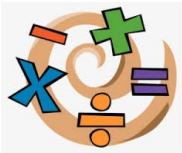
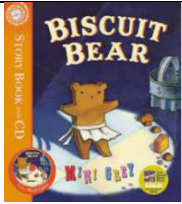
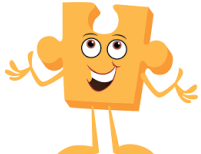


Year 1

Week beginning: Monday 7th September 2026

This week we are learning:	
English 	To write in sentences, remembering spaces between words. To use capital letters and full stops. We will be writing posters and invitations to a teddy bears picnic.
Phonics 	To review the following sounds: ai ee igh oa oo ar or ur oo ow oi ear Tricky words: no, go, so, my, by, to, into, out, the
Handwriting 	To form curly caterpillar letter correctly: c, a, o, d
Maths 	To represent real-life objects using counters, cubes or pictures and match them to the correct numeral. To match number words to numerals and amounts up to 10. To count on from any number up to 10.
Reading 	We will be reading <i>Biscuit Bear</i> by Mini Grey. To sequence events. To make predictions about what will happen next. 
Science 	To identify how weather changes across four seasons. We will be making weather mobiles.
PSHE 	To know how to keep safe at school. To know that we are special.

Art 	To draw a teddy or soft toy from observation.
Computing 	To learn how to use the tablets safely, respectfully and sensibly.
Music 	<u>Song of the Week:</u> 1899 Flight of the Bumblebee (Rimsky-Korsakov) We will be singing songs about teddy bears. To listen to and talk about what they like or dislike about the piece of music. To name instruments they can hear or see. To decide if the music is fast or slow. To explain how the music makes them feel.
PE 	Gymnastics: To follow instructions and practise skills that have been demonstrated. Games: To understand rules for being outside for PE. To listen carefully to instructions. To take part in team games.
Outdoor Learning 	To explore the woodland area and hunt for teddies. To take part in a Teddy Bears' picnic. To take part in team games and solve problems.

You may like to simply read them on the screen or use them as flashcards. If you do not have access to a printer, please ask your child's teacher to print them for you.
