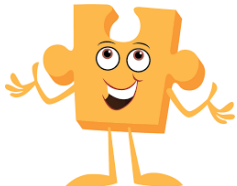


Year 1

Week beginning: Monday 14th September 2026

This week we are learning:	
English 	To write a simple sentence including a capital letter and full stop.
Phonics 	To review phase 3 sounds. Tricky words: no, go, so, my, by, to, into, out, the
Handwriting 	To form curly caterpillar letter correctly: c, a, d, g, o, q
Maths 	To find 1 more than a given number. To count backwards within 10. To find 1 less than a given number. To match one object to another to see if the groups are the same.
Reading 	To predict what will happen next in a story. To retrieve information to answer questions.
Science 	To identify how the weather changes across the seasons.
PSHE 	To understand the rights and responsibilities as a member of my class. To know that I belong to my class.

History 	To discuss the differences and similarity between old toys and modern toys.
PE 	Handball: To move fluently, changing direction and speed easily and avoiding collisions. To recognise space in their games and use it to their advantage. To have awareness of others when moving and playing. Golf: To explore different ways of moving with a ball. To perform basic skills needed for games with control and accuracy.
RE	To find out why the Bible is a special book for Christians. To learn about the Christian Creation story.

Below are some words you may like to practise reading with your child at home. Remember - the red words are tricky as we can't decode and blend them! You may like to simply read them on the screen or use them as flashcards. If your child would like a challenge, can they choose a few of the words to practise writing and spelling?
