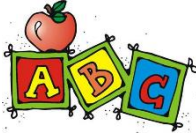


Week beginning 14th September 2026

This week In Year 2 we are learning:

English 	To punctuate sentences correctly. To use the conjunction 'because'. To make predictions about a text. To suggest an alternative ending. To select vocabulary to describe a character.
Maths 	To partition numbers to 100. To write numbers to 100 in words. To partition numbers to 100 in different ways.
Phonics 	To know the graphemes: su (treasure), si (vision), dge (bridge), y (gym), ge (large) To read the tricky words: move, improve, parents, shoe
Handwriting 	To form numerals correctly.
PE 	Golf: To explore different ways of moving. To move fluently changing direction and speed. To perform basic skills needed for games with control and accuracy. Handball: To show good awareness of others when playing games. To choose and use simple tactics to suit different situations.
Jigsaw PSHE 	To listen to other people and contribute my own ideas about rewards and consequences. To help make my class a safe and fair place.
Mindfulness 	To use breathing techniques to aid mindfulness.
Whole class reading 	To predict what might happen in a story. To use retrieval and inference skills to answer questions about a story.
Science 	To recognise the difference between things that are alive, were once alive or have never been alive. To classify objects into groups.
Art 	To use tone and texture to create an observational drawing.

Below are some words you may like to practise reading with your child at home. Remember - the red words are tricky as we can't decode and blend them! You may like to simply read them on the screen or use them as flashcards. If you do not have access to a printer, please ask your child's teacher to print them for you. If your child would like a challenge, can they choose a few of the words to practise writing and spelling?
