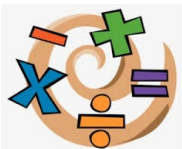
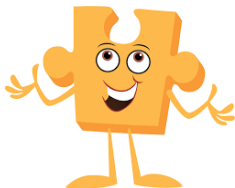


Year 1

Week beginning: Monday 21st September 2026

This week we are learning:	
English 	To write a sentence with a capital letter and a full stop. To write a sentence with an adjective.
Phonics 	To review words with two or more digraphs. Tricky words: What, when, he, she, we, be, me, have, love
Handwriting 	To form curly caterpillar letter correctly: e, s, f, l, i, t
Maths 	To can compare groups of objects and say whether there are more, fewer or the same. To compare numbers using the words “less than”, “greater than” and “equal to”, and the symbols q, G, and =. To compare numbers within 10 using the words “greater than”, “less than” and “equal to”, and the symbols G, q and =.
Reading 	To decode and blend words. To retrieve information from a text. To predict what will happen within a book.
Science 	To recognise how trees change across the seasons.
PSHE 	To understand the rights and responsibilities as a member of my class. To know how to make my class a safe place for everybody to learn. To understand what a school council is and to vote for our class representative.

Music 	To demonstrate an understanding of pulse using parts of the body.
PE 	Golf: To show increasing control when pushing, patting, throwing and catching a ball. To roll a ball with consistent accuracy. To develop movement and co-ordination. Handball: To show control of a ball with basic action. To describe what they have done or seen others doing.
Computing 	To learn how to use the tablets safely, respectfully and sensibly.
Art 	To shape paper to make a 3D drawing.
History 	To recognise differences and similarities between toys now and toys in the past. To observe and handle old toys. To ask and answer questions about toys in the past.
RE 	To find out why the Bible is a special book for Christians. To learn about the Christian Creation story.

Below are some words you may like to practice reading with your child at home. Remember - the red words are tricky as we can't decode and blend them! You may like to simply read them on the screen or use them as flashcards. If you do not have access to a printer, please ask your child's teacher to print them for you. If your child would like a challenge, can they choose a few of the words to practise writing and spelling?
