We will be celebrating 'Friendship Week' and making bracelets for a friend. We will be talking about what makes a good friend. The children are really enjoying our 'Jigsaw Jenie' sessions. This week we will talk about using gentle hands and understand that it is good to be kind to people.

Communication and Language

The children really enjoyed retelling the traditional tales last week. This week we will be encouraging the children to say the repeated language from *The Three Billy Goats Gruff* and *Jack and the Beanstalk*. For example, "Who's that crossing over MY bridge?" or "trip, trap, trip trap over the bridge." There is a vocabulary word mat attached.

Physical Development

We will be developing our fine motor skills by using tweezers to pick up pom poms, buttons and other items.

Literacy
