This week we will be continuing to talk about how we are all different to each other and how we all have different families.

Literacy

We will be reading non-fiction books to learn about the season of winter. We will also enjoy some winter stories, for example Nick Butterworth's 'One Snowy Night' and 'Winter Sleep' by Alex Morss, Cinyee Chiu and Sean Taylor.

Understanding the World

We will talk about what happens during winter and the differences between winter and the other seasons. We will also be designing our own ice art and watching what happens when the ice melts.

Communication and Language

This week we will be talking about what happens during winter and using lots of descriptive language when creating our ice art, for example freeze, frozen, melt, melting, dripping, water, glistening.
