

















Week beginning 22nd January 2024

This week In Year 2 we are learning:

English 	<u>The Minpins</u> To write a retell of a familiar story. To add a range of punctuation, including commas in a list and apostrophes for possession. 
Maths 	To subtract 2 two digit numbers. To subtract 2 two digit numbers involving exchange.
Whole class reading 	To use the 'Pawsome Gang' to answer written comprehension questions.
Little Wandle Spelling 	To know why some words end in 'k' or 'ck'? To know why some words end in 'ch' or 'tch'?
