

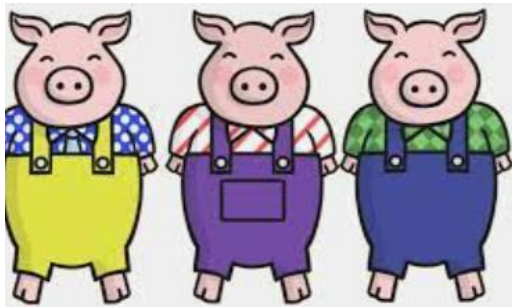
Personal Social Emotional Development
