Three little bunnies wondered what to do,

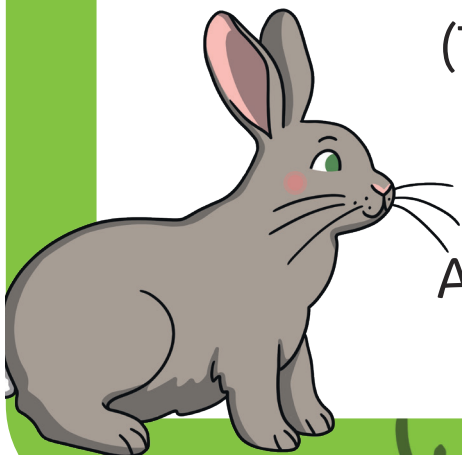
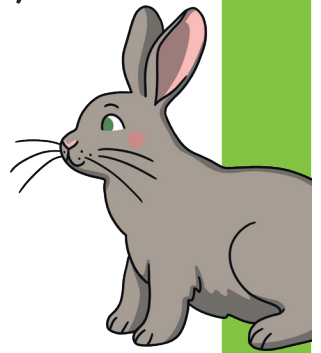
(Tap head as to think hard)

(Pretend to sleep)

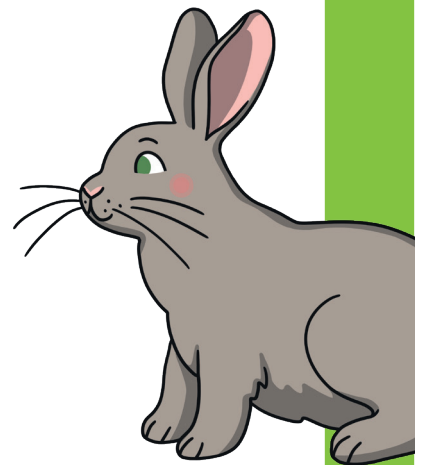
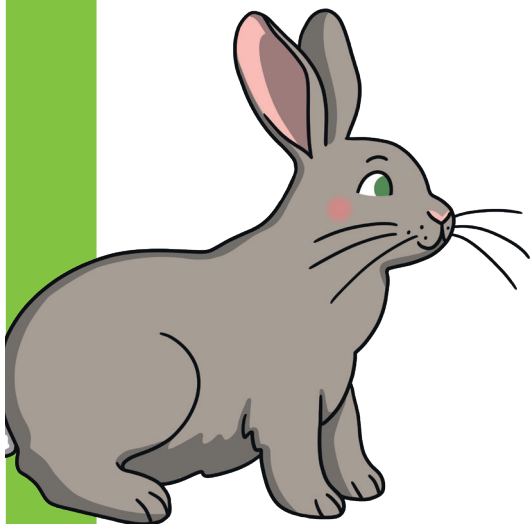
And then there were two.

(Hide another finger)

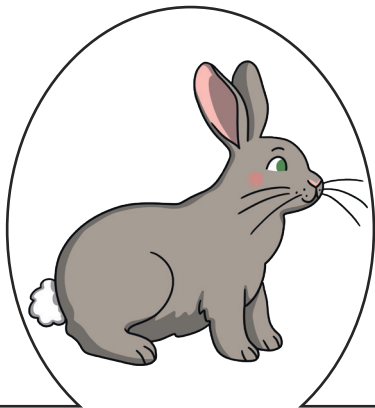


Two little bunnies went to have some fun,

(Cradle hand in your arm)

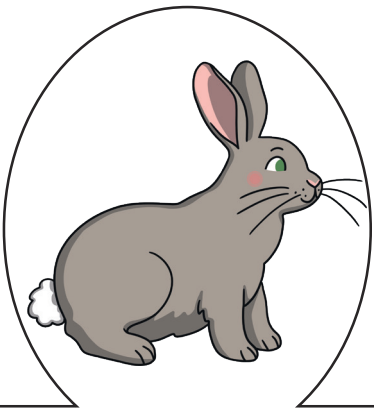


Cut out the shapes and glue the ends together to make your finger puppets.



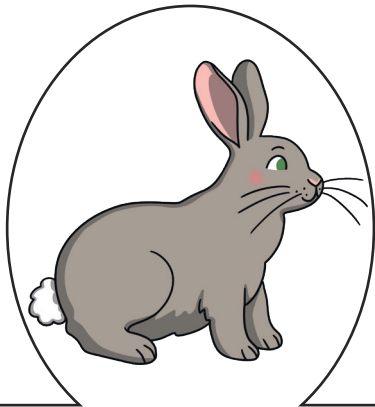

Cut around the lines



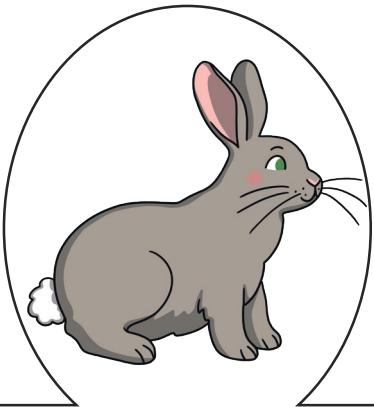

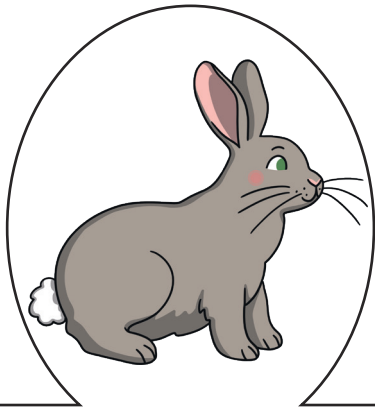
