Communication and Language


We will be re-telling the story of 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' by John Burningham and discussing the verbs used in the story such as teasing, squabbling, hopping, chasing and trampling.

Physical Development

This week our main focus will be on developing the children's gross and fine motor skills. We will be making books by cutting out pictures of animals from the story 'Mr Gumpy's Outing.' We will also be using our gross motor skills by practicing large movements with streamers.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be starting our new topic in our carpet sessions, 'Healthy Me'. We will be talking about the names for some parts of our body and starting to understand that we need to be active to be healthy.



Expressive Arts and Design

Our role play area will be a 'classroom'. The children will have lots of writing and number opportunities and be able to have a go at being a 'teacher'.

Literacy

We will be reading 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' by John Burningham and retelling the story using story props. We will also act it out in our role play area.
