Literacy

October marks Black History Month and we will be celebrating this by reading lots of stories from different cultures. The children have been really enjoying our nursery rhymes and we will continue to sing these and use the nursery rhyme props along with our singing.

Maths

Every week will be practicing counting out loud. We will count claps, jumps, taps, pats. We will introduce our Number of the Week, number 1. We will notice what we have 1 of, for example 1 nose, 1 mouth etc. We will also look at the numeral 1 and have a look to see if we can find it around our environment. At home, please continue to point out the number 1 and what you can find 1 of, for example 1 toothbrush, 1 spoon etc.

Communication and Language (CL)

We will be introducing the learning journeys to the children. We will be inviting them to stick in any work we have already saved such as drawings and paintings and asking them to tell us all about these. We will also encourage the children to draw something special with us to stick in, encouraging them to make their drawings more complex.

Physical Development (PD)

The children will be encouraged to develop their fine motor skills by mark making in different ways this week, using felt tips, crayons, chalk and printing with paint.

Understanding the World (UW)

Now that our 'All About Sheets' have been made into a class book, we will spend time looking at these with the children, and talking to them about their family and friends so that they can name and describe the people who are familiar to them.
