

















# Week beginning 14<sup>th</sup> October 2024

<p><b>PE – Games</b></p> 	<p>To throw, catch and bounce a ball in different ways when standing still or on the move.</p>
<p><b>PE – Gymnastics</b></p> 	<p>To continue to develop and apply different balances using large apparatus.</p>
<p><b>Art</b></p> 	<p>To sketch a traditional tale character.            To weave a bookmark.</p>
<p><b>DT</b></p> 	<p>To design a clay model of a traditional tale character.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p>To compare the suitability of materials for a particular use.            To gather data and use it to answer a question.</p>

<p><b>Reading</b></p> 	<p>Little Wandle group reading.            We will be reading and enjoying books in small groups this week focusing on word reading, prosody and comprehension.</p>
